(Reopening of admission portal)

As per recent notification regarding online admission, the Vidyasagar University (Ref.No. - VU/IC/mail/600/2018, dated 11th July) the online portal for admission will be **reopened (Web site: admission.ambigeriagovtcollege.org)** and the portal will remain open for 2 (two) days viz. **13.07.2018 & 14.07.2018**. Online Applications are invited from the candidates for admission in 1st year B.A. (Hons. & General) and B.Sc. (Honours & General) course for the Academic Session 2018-19.

The details of the list of **Vacant Seat** (department wise & categorically), **How to apply** are also enclosed herewith.

Important note to the Applicants:

- ❖ Online filling of application will start on: **13/07/2018. (11:45 A.M.)**
- ❖ Last date of online filling of application: **14/07/2018. (11:45 P.M.)**
- ❖ On-line admission process should be done based on merit point
- ❖ Prospective students should not be called for counselling or verification of documents during the process of admission.
- ❖ The verification process should be done only when the students report at the commencement of the classes in due course.
- ❖ Only e-payment will be available for the payment of admission fees through the payment gate way of the college web site portal.
- ❖ Please Note:
Printed copy of the application Forms and necessary testimonials, both original and photocopy, are to be brought on the scheduled date (will be notified later). The college authority reserves the right to reject any application form in case of any discrepancy.
- ❖ Candidates doing REGISTRATION THROUGH "ONLINE PAYMENT" need to pay: **Rs.100/- + (Online Bank Payment Charges)** for each course
- ❖ Candidates will apply for different courses in one single form. But they have to take multiple print outs; one for each application. If someone has already submitted one application and then want to do another one, in that case the candidate has to make fresh registration.

❖How to apply:

- 1) Scan your photograph and signature (*There is no limit of scan file size*)
- 2) Register yourself by visiting the said website, get registration number/username and password through SMS/ email. Keep the information stored for future use.
- 3) Login using registration number/ username and password
- 4) Follow Step-1, Fill up details of personal information,
- 5) Follow Step-2, and Step-3 to entry, the details of last exam passed and upload your scanned photograph and signature
- 6) Follow Step-4, fill up the subjects for which you want to apply
- 7) For Online Payment, Click on the “Online Payment” and proceed accordingly.
- 8) After final submission take the print out of the submitted form, paste photograph, signed in appropriate places.
- 9) Keep the printed/hard copy of the duly filled Application form/ forms (separate application form of each applied subject during documents verification after the commencement of 1st year classes).

- 1) Two copies of recent passport size photograph.
- 2) Self-attested Photocopy of Admit card of Madhyamik /Proof of age
- 3) Self-attested Photocopy of Mark sheet of qualifying Exam at Secondary level/ Madhyamik.

- 9) Permission letter from Vidyasagar University if candidate has passed 10+2 on or before 2015.

1. Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A. (Hons.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2016/2017/2018) are eligible for apply for Honours course in 1.Bengali, 2.English, 3.History, 4.Philosophy, 5.Political Science provided that he candidate must have passed in 5 (Five)/4 (Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

The following table shows the subjects or allied subjects required for admission in Hons. Courses:

History	No subject bar but preference to candidate with History

For GENERAL Candidates: 60%

For SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B Candidates:55%

2. Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A. (General)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Board/Councils are listed below) in the year 2016/2017/2018 are eligible to apply for General course with subjects 1.**Bengali**,2. **English**,3. **History**, 4.**Philosophy**, 5.**Political Science**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5 (Five)/4 (Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

Candidates passed the Vocational Course can apply in BA General Course only

1. Eligibility criteria for admission in B. Sc. (Hons.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2016/2017/2018) are eligible for apply for Honours course in 1.Physiology,2 .Botany, 3.Zoology, 4. Chemistry provided that the candidate must

have passed in 5 (Five)/ 4 (Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2016/2017/2018) are eligible to apply for General course with subjects **B.Sc. (General) Bio—any three from 1.Botany 2. Zoology, 3. Physiology, 4. Chemistry** or **B.Sc. (General) Pure Sc. -1. Physics, 2. Chemistry, 3. Mathematics**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/4 (Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

N.B.: A CANDIDATE PASSING 10+2 LEVEL BEFORE 2016 WITH ABOVE MENTIONED CRITERIA CAN ALSO APPLY AFTER GETTING SPECIAL PERMISSION FROM THE SECRETARY, U.G. COUNCIL VIDYASAGAR UNIVERSITY, MIDNAPORE.

❖ **Merit Point Calculation:**

Merit Point = X+Y for Honours Course applicants

X = 10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam counting the total marks of The **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.

Y = marks obtained in the applied subject as Hons, If that subject is not studied, consider the marks of one subject as indicated in the table:

Proposed Subjects	Subjects to be Considered
Bengali	Bengali
English	English
History	History/ 1st language
Philosophy	Philosophy/1st language
Political Science	Political Science/ 1st language

Note: If more candidates score same merit point, preference will be given to higher Y, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same Y; preference will be given to higher marks in 1st Language.

Merit Point = Z for Pass Course applicants

Z: for the applicants of the General Course, the merit point will be calculated counting the total marks of the **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of Environmental studies / science

HOW TO APPLY: (in Words)

For filling up the on-line application form carefully follow the subsequent steps:
